- Link Appraisal Targets to the mathematical outcomes achieved by girls (whilst maintaining or further improving the good standards achieved by boys)
- Maths Leader to draw up and implement a comprehensive Action Plan for Mathematics, which will be monitored and evaluated by senior leaders and governors
- Play an active part in the LA Better Mathematics Project during 2017-18
